Excellencies

- -would like to get several quotes on chairs and propose expenditure to barony
- -current chairs also difficult to put together and heavy
- -Cadwgan and Eadaoin purchased own chairs, painted baronial coat of arms on backs
- -this would make travel easier for baronage present and future
- -Francesca-how would they hold up? Answer: holding up very well after 6 years, just have been wiped with Pledge every once in a while
- -Gisla-these are for travel? Answer: correct
- -other part of proposal is getting current chairs to Egil for repairs
- -holes on current chairs have worked more open, cracks and chips elsewhere
- -Gisla-would it be prudent to get two sets? Answer: no, because these can be repaired for limited funds
- -thought is that new chairs, material for new seats, and repairing old chairs can be done under \$1000
- -Gisla proposes to do this, multiple seconds

Fun at the Zoo

Over the May $17^{\text{th}} - 18^{\text{th}}$ weekend, while some of our barony were out practicing for war, other members took to the pathways of the Akron Zoo! The Akron Zoo hosted its first-ever Renaissance Faire, and we as a barony were asked to participate. It was a beautiful weekend, and a bit of rain and wind could not keep the crowds away.

On Saturday, we had a great start, with seven members of our barony spending their day speaking to over 1,000 people who came through the zoo! We actually had so much interest in the SCA and our barony that we ran out of business cards. Children and adults alike were ecstatic to see and touch some of what we had on display.

Sunday was just a continuation of the excellent experience we had at the zoo. We had eight members of our barony and one member from Cleftlands join us! We handed out coloring pages, temporary tattoos, and sticker sheets to the kids and one of our participants even spent the day writing people's names in calligraphy for people to take home with them. We went through almost an entire box of business cards this day!

After speaking with zoo staff, there were approximately 10,000 people who came through the zoo over the course of the weekend, and we probably spoke to about half of them. Baronial Meeting Minutes, continued

- -Seneschal moves that we get quotes to be put before populace for secondary vote; motion carried
- -see Cadwgan for questions

Exchequer

- -18,725.30 in account as of last statement
- -deposited money from recent event, but have not paid out expenses
- -will be down to around 15,000 once expenses paid
- -checks written, but not distributed yet for expenses
- -15,564 after checks cashed
- -that tells you how much we have relative to proposal regarding Excellencies' chairs
- -two events to report on
- -March 30 rapier event with Aethelmearc-no admission fee, site cost \$125, took in \$137 in donations, made \$12
- -Rose Tourney-435 attendees, 141 were pre-registered
- -proceeds split 75 barony/25 kingdom because considered minor kingdom event
- -after expenses and paying kingdom, take home was \$2302
- -event was in Thistle, all but feast steward were Thistle volunteers
- -Thistle Seneschal has asked if there was anything barony could do to help their coffers so they can host big events eventually
- -proposal-we had anticipated 50/50 split, but it was 75/25; how about we give 25% we were not anticipating receiving to Thistle, which is \$767
- -Cadwgan-this would give Thistle extra money to grow so they can host their own event; they want to host the way Gwyntarian and Alderford do
- -His Excellency-propose even \$1000 to Thistle if possible
- -Francesca-in past when group has not had money, had another group sponsor, paid back money, then kept funds; should do that and several times if necessary
- -Genovefa-as barony, do we want to go with past precedent or create a new one helping a group more outright
- -Gisla-worried about kingdom and/or corpora taxing us with that much money, would rather distribute to one of our marches and see them grow; Alderford was taxed a while ago
- -Francesca-that was because of a past lawsuit
- -Patraic-did it that way in the past because baronial coffers had not grown to what they are now; we are doing well now
- -Seneschal-would like to put forward 25% because understandable and justifiable reason with how proceeds were split with kingdom
- -Nina-concerned about setting precedent; would we do same for Three Towers, several said yes
- -Cadwgan-if Three Towers puts in same effort that Thistle did, absolutely; we are only as strong as our individual marches, should be system moving forward
- -Genovefa-baronial event held in Thistle and Thistle had almost all event positions; this is different from a group asking for money vs a group that has put in the effort
- -Exchequer-technically second time Thistle has run an event; Thistle Seneschal stewarded Brendokenfest and many volunteers there were Thistle
- -Quentin-years ago, Alderford event in Tallmadge done together with Gwyntarian, and they split proceeds; Rose was held in and supported by Thistle, so there is no reason not to give them 25%

- -Her Excellency-event was brought forth in November by Thistle because Countess Ceinwen was asked to hold event by Kingdom; Thistle would do the work but needed help with money; we have gotten money back that we have paid, we will not be at a deficit; they can use money to do more events
- -motion for 25% to be gifted to Thistle-motion carried
- -Seneschal-please check with kingdom exchequer to make sure we are not violating anything by doing that before writing check
- -feed the sheep
